Divine Mercy Devotion

(Part 2 of 2)

Our Lord said, "When you go to confession, to this fountain of My mercy, the Blood and Water which came forth from My Heart always flows down upon your soul..." and "Every time



you go to confession, immerse yourself entirely in My mercy with great trust, so that I may pour the bounty of My grace upon your soul. When you approach the confessional, know this, that I Myself am waiting there for you. I am only hidden by the priest, but I Myself act in your soul. Here the misery of the soul meets the God of mercy" (Diary 1602) "Make your confession before Me. The person of the priest is... only a screen. Never analyze what sort of a priest that I am making use of; open your soul in confession to Me, and I will fill it with My light." (Diary 1725)

It is required of all Catholics to confess their serious sins at least once every year. If you haven't yet met this obligation please consider doing so.

There are five steps for a good confession:

(1) Examine your conscience and say an Act of Contrition; (2) Be sincerely sorry for your sins; (3) Confess your sins to a priest; (4) Resolve to amend your life; (5) After your confession, do the penance the priest assigns.

The procedure in the Confessional:

- You say: "Bless me Father, for I have sinned. It has been (state length of time) since my last confession. These are my sins..."
- Then tell your mortal sins and the number of times committed. If you have no mortal sin to confess, then confess the venial sins you have committed since your last confession. When you have finished telling your sins, you should say: "For these and all the sins of my past, I am truly sorry."
- The priest now gives the necessary advice, assigns your penance and may ask you to say an Act of Contrition. Then wait and listen as the priest gives the absolution.
- Then say, "Thank you, Father". Leave the confessional and perform the penance assigned by the priest.
